A WORD ABOUT OUR SPONSOR.

The Kiwanis Club of Reisterstown, Inc. was organized in August, 1935 and chartered October 1st of that year with fifty-two charter members. From the beginning and down through the last thirty-five years, various activities concerning youth have been the objectives by the several youth service committees.

For several years a summer playground program was conducted at the Franklin High School through arrangements made by Kiwanis with the Public Athletic League of Baltimore City. Down through the years similar activities have been provided by Kiwanis for the youth of the community.

In 1958, Kiwanis acquired the use of the property owned by the Reisterstown Volunteer Fire Company for a community recreation center. The area was graded and laid off for the purpose of providing several activities at the same time. A field house was erected with the necessary facilities for use during athletic events. Today these grounds are being used for daytime and evening events by various groups in the Reisterstown area.
